## NAVAL ASSOCIATION OF CANADA - VANCOUVER ISLAND (NAC-VI) Grant

PURPOSE: To support cadet training in Navy League of Canada - Vancouver Island Division

by assisting Corps with the purchase of training aids.

CRITERIA: To be used for training aid purchases only. Applies to Sea Cadet and Navy

League Corps.

RESTRICTIONS: May not be used to purchase equipment, office supplies or pay for operating

expenses.

Only one request per Corps per training year.

**AMOUNT:** \$500 per Corps per year

**BENEFACTOR:** Naval Association of Canada - Vancouver Island

APPLICATION: Corps Commanding Officers shall apply in writing on Corps letterhead to their

Branch Council. The letter shall state the amount being requested and the

purpose of the request.

If the Branch Council supports the request, the Branch shall forward the request to the *Treasurer, Vancouver Island Division*, who will distribute it amongst the

Division Council Executive.

A decision on whether the application is approved will be made at the next Division

Council Executive meeting.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT: Corps shall write a thank you letter to the NAC-VI c/o Secretary, Vancouver

Island Division, who will then forward the letter to the Naval Association of

Canada - Vancouver Island at the following address:

The letter shall also outline what training aids were purchased and what the cadets

have done with said training aids.

**REPLENISHMENT:** Periodically as required.

ADDITIONAL NOTES: If the Division Council Executive approves the request, the Treasurer shall raise

the necessary documentation, issue a cheque and notify the Naval Association of

Canada - Vancouver Island that a grant has been made on their behalf.
